The 33rd Annual March for Life was such a powerfully uplifting experience. In a time when so much of the world is dismissive of the value of life, I was completely surrounded by, according to the Washington Times, an estimated one hundred thousand of my brothers and sisters who share the same treasurable view on life, beginning with conception and ending with natural death. The relationship between those present that January weekend was much of what I envision of heaven. Walking through the street, fellow pro-lifers were able to communicate without using words. We all knew the urgency in the need to end the horrifying acts of abortion and euthanasia, and we were working together to fight for that end. This was my first March for Life attendance, and it certainly will not be my last.

Marching down Constitution Avenue that Monday morning was the most surreal event. The enormous crowd of pro-life brothers and sisters lined up, shoulder to shoulder, to show our belief in justice, not just for some, but for all. We were older and we were younger. We came from different races and ethnicities. Some of us had experienced, first hand, the act of abortion, and some of us had not. We were female and we were male. We came from separate immediate families, but we were together that morning creating one large family, with one large message.

As our Naples Youth for Life group marched and prayed the rosary for the end of this immoral act, I was astonished, after turning to look behind me, to realize that I was unable to see the point where the crowd ended. It was so touching to my heart to see all the supporters of the right to human life.

As I conclude, I hope that my sharing this experience inspires you readers to join our family next year, in Washington D.C., to aid in protecting the unprotected. We, as a nation, and as a family, need to stand together and say, "Women deserve better than abortion". We need to stop denying the facts and admit that abortion and euthanasia take the life of a living person. We need to stop playing God, step up to the plate and chant, "Hey-hey, Ho-Ho, Roe vs. Wade has got to go!"

Daughter's Suicide After Secret Abortion Leads Father to Activism

"I know, in my heart, it took a toll on her emotionally and mentally, that she couldn't recover from it. And it just breaks my heart that she didn't open up..."

A successful businessman, George Zallie began the foundation after hearing women speak about the pain of living with the fallout from having an abortion, at a retreat following his daughter's death.



"I heard guilt, remorse, loss," he recalls. "Their frankness was really astounding to me. It was helpful for me in understanding just what Stacy was going through . . . It became important to me to get the message out."

On Saturday, February 18th, more than a hundred of us were lucky to attend this dedication of a memorial at the new Royale Palm cemetery on Vanderbilt Beach Road, which includes a life-size bronze sculpture called "Hope." It features a likeness of Jesus comforting a young woman. Behind it is a polished black granite wall where plaques with a child's name can be put for remembrance. So far, there are a half dozen names on the wall. It's a place where mothers and fathers can come to remember their losses. The memorial was erected to help women cope with the loss of an unborn child. Here, parents can honor their children who were aborted or lost in miscarriages.

Sculptor Beverly Paddleford of Lander, Wyo., said that it was really God's work, not her's. Bob Block, who many of us know through our pro-life networks, was the master-of-ceremony. Saturday's dedication was really the result of Bob's many years of hard work.

Planned Parenthood Prez Portraying Abortion Business as Health Care Provider

Cecile Richards, the new president of the Planned Parenthood Federation of America, says the focus of her tenure at the helm of the nation's largest abortion business will be persuading Americans that it really focuses on women's health care first. ...

Richards, daughter of pro-abortion ex-Texas Gov. Ann Richards, came aboard the abortion business in January. Previously, she was the deputy chief of staff to California Rep. Nancy Pelosi, the Democratic leader in the House of Representatives.

As Planned Parenthood comes up on its 90th anniversary, Richards tells the Dallas Morning News her focus is to make the abortion business the "premier women's health care provider."

"When they turn 100 in 10 years, I want women and families to be able to access safe, affordable community-based health care in every state in this country," she told the newspaper.

However, the number of abortions the business performs has risen in each of the last two years and is now almost 20 percent of the 1.3 million abortions that take place annually in the United States.

According to figures from Planned Parenthood's annual report, its centers nationwide performed 244,628 abortions in 2003, a 6.1 percent increase from the year before. In 2004, Planned Parenthood performed 255,015, another 4.3 percent increase. ... Planned Parenthood performs 180 abortions for every woman it refers to an adoption agency, according to its own figures.

And when it comes to birth control pills, Jim Sedlak of STOPP International says the abortion business is overcharging women to make a substantial profit.

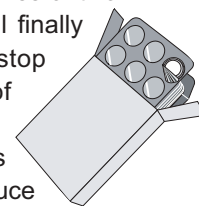
"Our research shows that Planned Parenthood sells a monthly supply of birth control pills for anywhere from \$16 to \$25, but pays just \$1.50 for them," he said.

Abortion Drug Deaths Prompt Planned Parenthood to Follow FDA Rules

More Dead Planned Parenthood RU 486 customers ...

After the Food and Drug Administration announced the dangerous RU 486 abortion drug claimed the lives of two more women, Planned Parenthood said it will finally follow the agency's recommendations and stop telling women to take it vaginally instead of orally. Though the FDA recommends using the abortion pills orally, the abortion company tells women to use it vaginally, claiming it will produce fewer complications. Planned Parenthood also uses a different dosage of the abortion drug than the FDA suggests. Four California women previously all died within a week of using the abortion drug they received from Planned Parenthood abortion businesses.



The women died after using the abortion drug and contracting infections of *Clostridium sordellii*. Because the bacteria causes problems so quickly, and without the normal telltale signs, the

FDA has placed its highest black box warning label on the abortion pills. ... The FDA did not release the names of the two women who died most recently or say where they lived. However, Planned Parenthood acknowledged they were customers. It said one of the women died within days of using the abortion drug and the other died five weeks later.

Despite the change, Planned Parenthood will still violate FDA guidelines by telling women to take the second part of the abortion pill process at home. The FDA says that should be done in a medical office to monitor the women for any complications. Kneer said the abortion business would focus on educating its staff about the change in use, but claimed there was no proof yet that the abortion drugs were responsible for the women's deaths.

March of Dimes...

We are approaching that time of the year – March – when the “March of Dimes” hype will be everywhere. This is just a reminder that the pro-life boycott of The March of Dimes still hasn't been lifted. Basically the official March of Dimes position is to say that it is neutral regarding abortion. How would you view someone who said that they were neutral about bank robbery? The March of Dimes strongly promotes amniocentesis. This is “a search and destroy” birth defect test. Amniocentesis is done too early during pregnancy for any option except abortion. Down's Syndrome is the most looked for birth defect and ninety percent of those found are killed by abortion. We don't think that fighting birth defects includes killing those who have them.

More recently two other areas have come to light. The first is supporting the use of fetal tissue from abortions for science. One usual justification, just like Hitler, is that they were going to die anyhow. MOD also supports “fetal reduction.” Many fertility treatments involve producing many eggs to increase the chances for conception. Sometimes the result is a large pregnancy. “Fetal reduction” is the killing of some for the possible benefit of the remainder.

Even though people seem to cite many MOD benefits, the pro-life community feels that that is greatly overshadowed by what is described above, and justifies the continued boycott.

More March of Dimes ... Preterm Births ... At least 48 published studies

At least 48 published studies have shown significantly higher risk of premature birth and low birth weight deliveries among women with a history of abortion. One of the best studies, a record-based study from Denmark, shows that the risk doubled after one abortion. A doubling of risk among an estimated one-fourth of delivering women who have a prior history of abortion would result in a 25 percent increase overall. One of our greatest responsibilities, as advocates for life, is to educate our youth on the pro-life movement. Through this, we will ultimately save lives. What better place to do so than the very place students go to learn? Action For Life has had the wonderful opportunity to spread our pro-life message through our local high

school newspapers, and I have had the amazing opportunity to help them do so.

Each high school has a newspaper committee that works together to create monthly journalistic issues. For instance, Palmetto Ridge High School has chosen the familiar Bear to be their school mascot. In honor of that mascot, they have chosen the title of their newspaper to be, The Paw Print. Every month I contact, in respect of Action For Life, the teacher or student in charge of each school newspaper. I submit a newly created ad with an educational and enticing pro-life message. I make sure to include the local Action For Life telephone number in hopes it will help any young person in crisis or need of assistance. This is such an important task, and I am so grateful this community has an organization such as Action For Life to take on this duty.

I will end with a brief story my seventeen year old sister told me. She attends Palmetto Ridge High School, and after the first advertisement I created was displayed in their school newspaper, she watched a group of kids gather together and crack jokes about what the advertisement had to say. One particular thing they were laughing about was the telephone number, repeating it over and over. In the advertisement the telephone number read 239-262-LIFE. At first I was displeased to hear this, but the longer I thought about it, my frame of mind changed. In the future, if one of those students finds themselves pregnant, or in need of help, they may very well remember that moment, and likely remember that telephone number. That, in and of itself, makes every second I spend working with Action For Life on these school advertisements worth it. Spreading the word that abortion does not have to be any person's choice is an essential mission, and we are working very hard to achieve it.

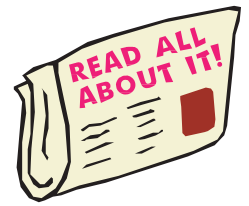

Speaking of Supreme Court decisions... how about... Humanizing Eugenics: A bad idea bred of good intentions.

In 1927, physicians at the Virginia Colony for Epileptics and Feeble-minded in Lynchburg sterilized a young woman named Carrie Buck. Although doctors at state institutions across the country had performed sterilizations before, Carrie's case was unusual. Her sterilization had received the imprimatur of the U.S. Supreme Court. In *Buck v. Bell*, the court upheld the state of Virginia's right to sterilize, forcibly, so-called feeble-minded individuals. "It is better for all the world," Justice Oliver Wendell Holmes Jr. wrote for the majority, "if instead of waiting to execute degenerate offspring for crime, or to let them starve for their imbecility, society can prevent those who are manifestly unfit from continuing their kind." Holmes concluded: "Three generations of imbeciles are enough."

The Supreme Court ... a pro-life comment... from American Life League

ALL applauds Alito confirmation David Bereit, executive director of American Life League, issued the following statement regarding the confirmation of Samuel Alito as justice to the U.S. Supreme Court: We are extremely hopeful that the confirmation of Samuel Alito will lead to a greater protection of all human life including innocent children at risk of losing their lives to abortion. Justice Alito's confirmation to the nation's highest court offers pro-life Americans reason for hope and optimism about the future. His record suggests that he will help to ensure justice for all Americans - born and pre-born.

Justice Alito's confirmation was not an easy victory, but pro-lifers worked tirelessly to ensure that the tragedy of abortion was a focal point throughout the confirmation process. Prior to the vote in the Senate Judiciary Committee, ALL representatives delivered thousands of petitions signed by citizens across the country calling for the approval of Judge Alito. Efforts like this were crucial in helping to assure Justice Alito's confirmation.

Pro-life Americans are praying that Justice Alito will live up to his promise, and uphold a strict interpretation of constitutional law - not legislate from the bench. There is nothing in the United States Constitution that gives anyone a right to kill an innocent human person, by abortion or any other means, and we are hopeful that Justice Alito will recognize that reality in all abortion related decisions that come before him on our nation's highest court.
